STP-281-1(117) IN RED CLOUD; C.N. 42619 THE NEED FOR IMPROVEMENT

This project would provide much needed improvements to U.S. Highway 281 (US-281) and U.S. Highway 136 (US-136) within the city of Red Cloud in Webster County.

The proposed improvements include:


- reconstructing pavement
- constructing new sidewalk and curb ramps
- reusing ornamental lighting in the downtown when possible
- constructing storm sewer and utility improvements

These proposed improvements would improve the travel efficiency and safety along these portions of US-281 and US-136.

removing and replacing existing street lighting;










STP-281-1(117) IN RED CLOUD; C.N. 42619 TIMELINE

NDOT is currently in the Preliminary Design and Public Input phase of this project. Construction could begin as early as summer 2025 and be completed by summer 2026.

The proposed project would require the acquisition of additional property rights, which could include new right-of-way (ROW), control of access (CA), permanent easements (PE), and/or temporary easements (TE).

If your property is impacted by this project, you will be contacted by a representative once the design footprint has been established.










STP-281-1(117) IN RED CLOUD; C.N. 42619 **Potential Project Impacts**

Red Cloud City Park is within the project area; impacts are anticipated due to sidewalk and curb work.

Effects to historic properties are being evaluated and the proposed project is seeking ways to avoid adversely affecting historic properties. Comments related to historic properties would be taken at the open house public meeting.










STP-281-1(117) IN RED CLOUD; C.N. 42619 **Typical Cross Sections**


US-136/W 4th Ave within Main St Historic District



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
