NH-480-9(3) I-480 Bridges, 20 St - Missouri River; C.N. 22611

Dear Citizen:

Enclosed is updated project information regarding the transportation improvement project on Interstate 480 (I-480) in Douglas County. The Nebraska Department of Transportation (NDOT) will improve approximately 1.24 miles of I-480. The project will require short-term temporary closures along I-480 while work is completed. Detours will be provided for both local and interstate traffic. Additionally, short-term temporary pedestrian detours will be required while bridge work is completed.

Hawkins Construction Company has been awarded the contract. Work is expected to begin in March 2021 and be complete by summer 2023 2021. Below are new/updated project details.

- Due to recent low parking volumes, a temporary parking lot will no longer be constructed. Any
 necessary additional parking will be absorbed at the City of Omaha parking garages P1, P5, P6 and P7.
 The contractor will coordinate with the City of Omaha prior to closing any parking lots to ensure that
 parking needs can be met.
- The detour for the 17th Street on-ramp to westbound I-480 will utilize 17th Street, Cuming Street and 13th Street.
- The 14th Street on-ramp to eastbound I-480 will be closed for approximately 15 days. The detour will utilize 14th Street and Douglas Street.
