October Traffic Fatality Toll

November 17, 2017 (Lincoln, Neb.) — During the month of October 2017, twelve persons were killed in traffic crashes on Nebraska roadways, according to data collected by the Nebraska Department of Transportation.

- ◆ These 12 fatalities occurred in 11 crashes
- ◆ Four of the eight vehicle occupants killed were not using safety belts
- ◆ No fatalities occurred on the interstate, four were on other highways, and eight took place on local roads
- ◆ Three of the fatalities were pedestrians
- ◆ One of the fatalities was a motorcyclist
- ◆ One fatality resulted from a collision with a train
- ◆ Five of the fatalities were age 24 or younger
- ◆ Seven of the fatalities occurred in rural locations

- ◆ There were 14 fatalities in October of 2016.
- ◆ 106 of the 140 vehicle occupants killed during 2017 (76%) were not wearing safety belts.
