Licensed as County Highway Superintendents are Ms. Jolene R. Gubbels of Hubbard and Mr. Roger Ray Heusinkvelt of Sprague.

Licensed as both County Highway and City Street Superintendents are Mr. Ryan Alan Flaherty of Aurora; Mr. Nicholas E. Hoffman of Norfolk; and Mr. Andrew Wilshusen of Lincoln.

Calentine is the Deputy Director of Public Works for the City of La Vista.

Gubbels is an Administrative Assistant for the Dakota County Highway Department and Heusinkvelt is a Senior Equipment Operator for Lancaster County.

Flaherty is the Assistant Superintendent for Hamilton County Highway Department; Hoffman is a Senior Project Engineer for McLaury Engineering; and Wilshusen is a Project Engineer for JEO Consulting Group.
