Maintenance Work Will Begin on N-4 near Wilcox

June 29, 2020 (McCook, Neb.) — Weather permitting, a cold milling project will begin July 6 on N-4, according to the Nebraska Department of Transportation. Cold milling is a process of removing deteriorated asphalt in preparation of placing a chip seal to improve the roadway surface and drivability.

State maintenance forces will be performing the cold milling and chip seal from Reference Post 24.75 to Reference Post 36.75, from N-44 junction to N-10 junction. One-lane traffic will be maintained with the use of a pilot car and flaggers. The cold milling work is anticipated to take approximately 6 days. The chip seal will be performed in August.

Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously in and near construction zones and to buckle up.
