Traffic Update on US-6 and Adams Central Avenue, Hastings Area

July 31, 2020 (Lincoln, Neb.) — The current closures on Adams Central Avenue (north and south of US-6) will not be open to traffic prior to the start of the school year due to recent weather conditions, according to the Nebraska Department of Transportation (NDOT).

Weather permitting, the north and south legs of the intersection are anticipated to open in approximately three weeks, following the start of the school year. US-6 will remain open to traffic, utilizing alternate school routes is recommended; and suggested routes would utilize S Osage Avenue, W DLD Road, and Southern Hills Drive.

In addition, an Adams County resurfacing project will begin August 3. The project will start just south of 12th Street on Adams Central Avenue and run 1.75 miles south to the north side of the roundabout between the elementary and high school.

Werner Construction will move equipment on site and begin work the week of August 3, with anticipated completion by Wednesday, August 12. Adams Central Avenue will remain open to traffic with the use of a pilot car through the construction area.

Motorists are reminded to drive cautiously in and near construction zones, to expect delays, and buckle up.

TRAFFIC UPDATES

US-6 will be open during all phases of construction.
Below is a summary of traffic impacts to Adams Central Avenue.



Adams Central Avenue/US-6 Intersection

The Nebraska Department of Transportation (NDOT) will not have the current closures on Adams Central Avenue (north and south of US-6) open prior to the start of the school year due to recent weather conditions. The north and south leg of the intersection is anticipated to be open in just under three weeks following the start of the school year. Although US-6 will remain open to traffic, recommended alternate school routes are provided below.
