Presentation Focus: The panel will be well versed in the organizational structure and technical responses provided in the Statement of Qualification for this RFQ. NDOT asks that you not focus a lot of time presenting on those areas unless there have been changes you want to highlight. Instead, NDOT would like to learn more about how your team will address these topics:

- a. NDOT added Lead Based Paint (LBP) surveys this year. How will your firm combine or separately handle LBP and ACM surveys for maximum efficiency?
- b. Presentation of collected survey information in a more useable form vs. just paper reports. What improvements can be made to leverage this data for future use?
- c. Strategies for use of Phase I and Phase II Environmental Site Assessments associated with purchase of ROW and/or site characterization during the project development process, and as a potential seller when NDOT is considering sale of a maintenance facility or other similar property?
- d. UST spill/release clean-up: What are generally the fastest/most cost-effective methods to reach NDEE clean-up goals/standards? What innovative technology has your firm used recently to achieve No Further Action status for NDEE Title 200?
- e. Each firm should be prepared to answer a wide variety of Committee questions at the conclusion of their prepared presentation.
