Omaha Metro Drivers Should Prepare for Busy Construction Season

May 27, 2021 (Lincoln, Neb.) — Construction season is beginning to ramp up in the Omaha metro area, and drivers should be prepared for traffic delays and other impacts to their commute throughout the summer, according to the Nebraska Department of Transportation (NDOT).

Major construction project areas include:

- Interstate 80 (I-80) at the following locations –
 - ~~I-480 on-ramp to 50th Street~~ Eastbound from 50th Street to I-480
 - 84th Street Interchange
 - Nebraska Highway 66 (N-66) to N-50
- I-480, 20th Street to the Missouri River
- US-75 and I-480 Interchange, Burt and Cuming Street Bridges
- I-680, I-80 to Fort Street

More information including traffic impacts and timeframes for the projects listed above, as well as other projects, can be found at ndot.info/mtm.

Traffic impacts may include delay, longer commute times, reduced number of driving lanes, and detours. NDOT plans major traffic shifts and closures for overnight work to the greatest extent possible to reduce impacts. However, some construction activities may need to occur during the day to be completed safely and efficiently.
