Question #1: (page 5) Under the survey services scope it states that the Consultant will complete supporting preliminary ground survey. Does NDOT have an idea of what the level of effort this work will be or can you provide more details on what would be included in the initial scope.

- **NDOT will be conducting a photogrammetric/aerial lidar flight this Fall. Supporting preliminary ground survey will consist of surveying all drainage structures and small segment of the hard surface to check quality of the aerial lidar acquisition. If quality of data for the pavement from the aerial flight is lacking, survey of the hardscape throughout the corridor may be required to incorporate into the rest of the data collected via aerial flight.**

Question #2: Standard Work Category 212 (LiDAR Acquisition & Processing) is listed on page 2. Is this the supporting ground survey referred to in question 1 or is there something specific this Service is needed for? And at what level of effort does NDOT anticipate this service? Mobile LiDAR for full corridor or spot locations?

- **This was inadvertently left in the RFQ. We are not requiring the consultant selected under this RFQ to utilize lidar technology.**
