Presentation Focus: The panel will be well versed in the organizational structure and technical responses provided in the Statement of Qualification for this RFQ. We ask that you not focus a lot of time presenting on those areas unless there have been changes you want to highlight. Instead, we suggest the interview contains information such as the following:

- It will be important to create a concise purpose and need for this project so that alternatives can be screened. Additionally, there are many environmental resources in this area that must be considered, some with competing regulations. Please discuss your strategy to effectively evaluate this scenario.
- Detail your anticipated approach to stakeholder outreach and involvement to maintain forward momentum on the project.
- Describe how to best develop this project while ensuring NDOT/IDOT can take advantage of new funding opportunities that may become available.
- This project could have a long development time with a potential letting that is five or more years from now. Describe how you can ensure capacity and team continuity, including the PM and any subconsultants, so the project can progress through each phase efficiently.
- Each firm should be prepared to answer a wide variety of Committee questions at the conclusion of their prepared presentation.
