**Presentation Focus:** The panel will be well versed in the organizational structure and technical responses provided in the Statement of Qualification for this RFQ. NDOT asks that you not focus a lot of time presenting on those areas unless there have been changes you want to highlight. Instead, NDOT suggests the interview contains information such as the following:

- How you will work through the project to help NDOT **adapt a "city-centric" framework to a mostly rural network**. Talk about your experience helping similarly situated DOT's adapt and adopt complete streets concepts to their unique reality.
- How you will guide the NDOT (and its stakeholders) through process of **balancing complete streets policy elements against practical elements** such as cost, context, and the needs of motorized users.
- Examples of how you have helped your clients **establish frameworks to capture and communicate progress/success on CS policy elements in the context of broader Agency Goals and Planning priorities**. Also describe your experience in helping Agencies integrate CS policy frameworks into preexisting Agency plans, policies, design guidance and overall goals.
- Each firm should be prepared to answer a wide variety of Committee questions at the conclusion of their prepared presentation.
