

Asphalt Field Technician I/II Training

This is on-line certification training for personnel performing NDOT Asphalt Field Technician I/II inspection. The class consists of:

- 1. Pretest
- 2. Video Part 1 is approximately 1.5 hours
- 3. Video Part 2 is approximately 2.25 hours.
- 4. Final Exam

Pretest

We recommend taking the pretest as you are watching the videos. Save the completed pretest, it must be submitted when requesting your final exam reservation date. You must pass the pretest with 70% or better to take the final exam.

Videos

There are 2 videos, you can watch them at your own pace. You can pause or restart the video and watch as many times as you like, they are on a link we will provide, on YouTube.

Final Exam

The final exam will be a proctored exam on WebEx. The exam is open book, open notes. You must have an operational microphone and video camera during the exam at all times, no exceptions. You must pass the final exam with 80% or greater for certification, otherwise you must start back over with the training.

Summary

Here is a quick summary of what you need to do.

Open the Pretest and save it to your desktop under your actual name as the filename. Then watch the videos at your own pace and fill out the pretest as you go, we think this is best.
