N-79 Between Raymond Rd. and County Rd. A Will Open to Traffic

November 28, 2018 (Lincoln, Neb.) — Weather permitting, N-79 between Reference Post 5+04 and Reference Post 12+43 will open to traffic by December 2, according to the Nebraska Department of Transportation.

N-79 traffic has been detoured between Raymond Road and County Road A since March of 2018 to accomplish grading, culvert construction and bridge replacements. The remaining work, which includes grading and an asphaltic concrete overlay, will be performed under traffic-maintained conditions. Some work will continue through the winter months when conditions are favorable. Flaggers and a pilot car will be used to control traffic through the work zones when necessary.

Motorists can expect delays at the flagging stations. A speed limit of 60 mph will be in effect, along with a 12' width restriction. It is anticipated that the project will be completed by July of 2019. As a reminder, extra caution should be used when travelling through any work zone.
