NOTICE OF HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

# Cody Ave. East, Alliance

NH-2-1(123); C.N. 51399

Identified as **Cody Ave. East, Alliance**, the proposed project would resurface approximately 1.60 miles of Nebraska Highway 2 (N-2) located in Box Butte County.

The proposed project would begin about 0.66 miles east of the west corporate limits of Alliance, at mile marker (MM) 85.96 and extend east to MM 87.56. The roadway section from MM 86.58 to MM 86.78 would be excluded from the project to preserve the existing brick surfacing. Construction may begin and/or end approximately 200 feet ahead of or beyond the actual project limits to accommodate transitioning the pavement.

The purpose of the proposed project is to preserve the transportation asset, improve the reliability of the transportation system and perpetuate the mobility of the traveling public. The need for the proposed project is based on the condition of the existing roadway.

Proposed improvements consist of repairing existing concrete and asphalt, milling and resurfacing. Concrete pavement would be removed and replaced from approximately MM 86.04 to MM 86.19. Curb ramps would be built or upgraded to meet state and federal requirements.

This project may require the acquisition of additional property rights, which could include new right-of-way (ROW), control of access (CA), permanent easements (PE), and/or temporary easements (TE). If your property is impacted by this project, you will be contacted by a representative once the design footprint has been established. Access to adjacent properties would be maintained during construction, but may be limited at times due to phasing requirements.

No wetland impacts are anticipated.

Construction is tentatively scheduled to begin in spring 2020, with anticipated completion by fall 2020.

The proposed project would be constructed under traffic with lane closures controlled by approved temporary traffic control devices and practices; however, the project would require detouring N-2 through traffic while concrete pavement is being replaced from approximately MM 86.04 to MM 86.19 (between Howard Street and Black Hills Avenue). A designated detour would be provided utilizing N-2, U.S. Highway 385 (US-385) and Kansas Street.

NDOT has worked to develop this project to minimize inconvenience and hardships. We are dedicated to improving Nebraska's highway system and with your help we can achieve this goal.
