NOTICE OF HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Holdrege South

NH-183-1(118); C.N. 71189

Identified as *Holdrege South*, the proposed project would resurface approximately 9.38 miles of U.S. Highway 183 (US-183) located in Harlan and Phelps counties.

The proposed project would begin about 0.16 miles south of the junction of US-183 with Nebraska Highway 4 (N-4), at mile marker (MM) 20.97, and extend north to MM 30.35, 0.02 miles south of the junction of US-183 with U.S. Highway 6 (US-6)/ U.S. Highway 34 (US-34). Construction may begin and/or end approximately 500 feet ahead of or beyond the actual project limits to accommodate transitioning the pavement and/or updating guardrail.

The purpose of the proposed project is to preserve the transportation asset, improve the reliability of the transportation system and perpetuate the mobility of the traveling public. The need for the proposed project is based on the condition of the existing roadway and bridge.

Proposed improvements consist of milling and resurfacing the roadway and surfaced shoulders with asphalt, removing and replacing guardrail, and culvert extensions. Existing surfaced driveways and intersections would be resurfaced and rumble strips added to shoulders. The 4-lane segment of US-183 within Holdrege would be restriped to a 3-lane roadway with a center left-turn lane. Additional work would include reconstructing a railroad crossing and repairing and resurfacing the bridge over Turkey Creek (Structure Number S183 02243).

The proposed project would require the acquisition of additional property rights, which could include new right-of-way (ROW), control of access (CA), permanent easements (PE), and/or temporary easements (TE).

If your property is impacted by this project, you will be contacted by a representative once the design footprint has been established. Access to adjacent properties would be maintained during construction but may be limited at times due to traffic phasing requirements.

Minor wetland impacts are anticipated; no mitigation would be required.

Construction is tentatively scheduled to begin in spring 2021, with anticipated completion in fall 2021.

The proposed project would be constructed under traffic with lane closures controlled by appropriate traffic control devices and practices.

NDOT has worked to develop this project to minimize inconvenience and hardships. We are dedicated to improving Nebraska's highway system and with your help we can achieve this goal.
