Information Open House October 10 for Improvements to I-129 in South Sioux City

September 26, 2019 (Lincoln, Neb.) – The Nebraska Department of Transportation (NDOT) will hold a public information open house regarding proposed improvements to Interstate 129 (I-129) in South Sioux City in Dakota County. The meeting will be held at the First Lutheran Church, 3601 Dakota Ave., in South Sioux City, on October 10, 5:00-7:00 p.m.

The proposed project is 3.23 miles in length along I-129 located in South Sioux City. The project would start approximately 0.55 miles west of the grade separation of I-129 under southbound U.S. Highway 75 (US-75)/U.S. Highway 77 (US-77) at approximately U.S. Highway 20 (US-20) mile marker (MM) 428.37 and extend east to the bridge over the Missouri River at I-129 MM 3.05.

Proposed improvements on this project consist of bridge repairs, bridge overlay, and removing and replacing guardrail. The roadway, surfaced shoulders, and ramps and loops at both the US-77 and Dakota Avenue interchanges would be milled and resurfaced with asphalt. Several bridge structures on I-129 would undergo repairs. Several bridge structures over I-129 at US-75/US-77 would also undergo repairs. Additional work would include guardrail improvements and replacing sign trusses over the roadways.

The proposed resurfacing and bridge repair work on I-129 and US-75/US-77 would be constructed under traffic with lane closures controlled with approved temporary traffic control; however, local traffic utilizing the ramp accesses along I-129 within the project area would require detours. These detours could be in place for up to two years. Additional detour information will be provided at the meeting.

The project is tentatively scheduled to begin in the spring of 2020 and could be completed by the fall of 2021.
