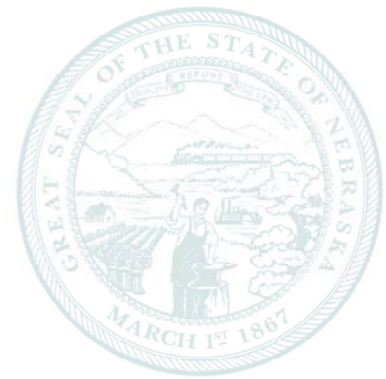

Information Open House October 22 for Improvements to Intersection of N-50 and Platteview Road in Springfield

October 8, 2019 (Lincoln, Neb.) – The Nebraska Department of Transportation (NDOT) will hold a public information open house regarding the proposed improvement of the intersection of Nebraska Highway 50 (N-50) and Platteview Road in Sarpy County. The meeting will be held at the Springfield Community Center, 104 Main St., in Springfield, on October 22, 4:00-6:00 p.m.

The proposed project would involve widening and/or replacing pavement, installing a traffic signal, removing and replacing guardrail and roadway lighting modifications. The proposed project would start at mile marker (MM) 82.60 and extend approximately 1,100 feet west and approximately 800 feet east of the intersection on Platteview Road.

The proposed project would require the acquisition of additional property rights, which could include new right-of-way (ROW), control of access (CA), permanent easements (PE), and/or temporary easements (TE). Property owners who are impacted will be contacted once the final design has been established.

Construction could begin as early as spring of 2021 and be completed by the fall of 2021. The proposed project would require temporary closure of Platteview Road west of N-50. A designated detour would be provided and would utilize 156th Street, Fairview Road and N-50. The remainder of the project would be constructed in phases with lane closures controlled by appropriate traffic control.
