WHAT IS REQUIRED?

- Be enrolled (or plan to enroll) in an approved technical program at a partnering technical college.
- Meet the college's pre-enrollment/ enrollment and academic requirements.
- Stay enrolled full-time, maintain good academic standing, and complete enough credits to graduate within 24 months.
- Be able to work part-time as an intern during the work week and school breaks.
- Stay engaged throughout the internship and program.
- Demonstrate good organization, decisionmaking, and problem-solving skills.
- Show attention to detail, initiative, and teamwork.
- Be punctual.
- Must showcase professional conduct in the workplace, the school, and beyond.
