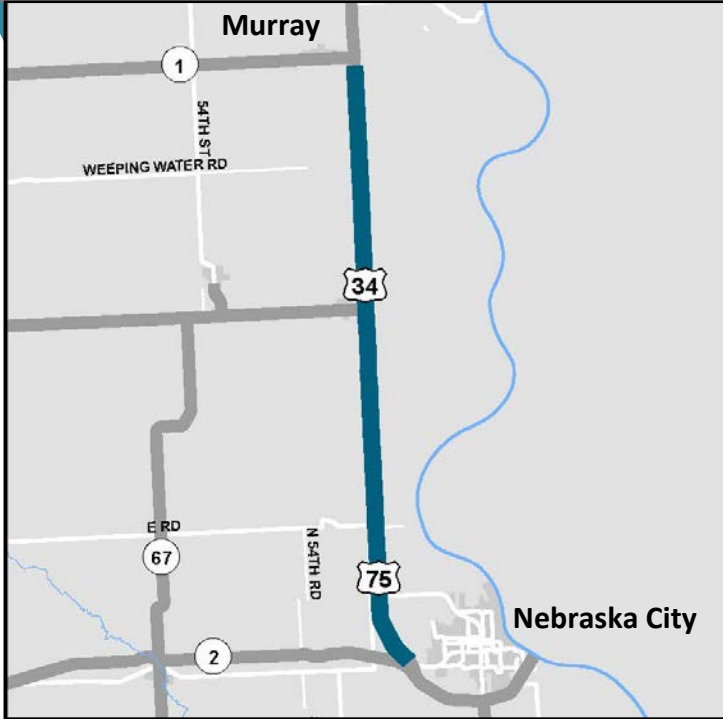


PROJECT PROFILE:

Project: US 75 from Nebraska City to Murray, 4-lane divided expressway

Estimated project cost: \$79M

Length of project: 17 miles

WHY IT WAS SELECTED

Completes a Gap in the Expressway System:

This 17-mile stretch of US 75 four-lane expansion, which spans from Nebraska City to Murray, will fill a gap and make progress toward completing the Expressway System. NDOR will begin design work now so that this project will be ready for future construction.

Builds on Previous Investments: This project helps deliver on the 1988 commitment Nebraska made to expand its Expressway System. In addition, significant investment has already been made along the US 75 corridor and this project is an important step toward the eventual completion of the Expressway System.

Supports Continued Growth: An upgrade of this roadway would help support continued development along the corridor. Nebraska City and the Union area are already experiencing some growth and development, which will be enhanced by improved infrastructure. Currently, more than 5,800 vehicles travel this 17-mile stretch each day.
