

GUIDANCE TO REQUEST A CHANGE OF NATIONAL OR STATE FUNCTIONAL CLASSIFICATION WHICH CHANGES ONLY THE COUNTY OR CITY SYSTEM

A County or City may request the Department of Transportation to reclassify any segment of highway, road, or street for which they have jurisdictional responsibility. Cities with a population less than 5,000 may request a reclassification of any segment of road for which they have jurisdictional responsibility through their County Board. Reference Neb. Rev. Stat. 39-2112.

County or City officials' should make a thorough study to determine if the facility qualifies for reclassification and provide the following information.

- A brief narrative of the reason for reclassification.
- One copy of the Boards Resolution requesting reclassification.
- Historical and current average daily traffic counts (If available).
- Map showing the location of the subject road.

Requests involving a county line road or a road intersecting a county line are to be coordinated with the adjacent County. Both Counties must agree either separately or together, to request reclassification and provide appropriate supporting data.
