<u>Temporary Pavement Marking – Quick Reference Guide</u>

NDOR Field personnel will determine contract requirements.

NDOR Field personnel will determine the product(s) used for temporary pavement marking (overlay solid, overlay broken, etc.).

Contractor will apply temporary pavement marking.

In accordance with the material requirements denoted on the SMGR Sampling Checklist, the NDOR Field personnel will create a SMGR sample record.

Material Code, Name, and Description:

422TPM – Temporary Pavement Marking

Test Templates:

CHF006001 - Temporary Pavement Marking - Field

When completing the test template, the previously determined product will be selected from the slates of temporary pavement marking. The materials are filtered by type and manufacturer. If multiple types of materials are used, for example paint and tape, both materials can be recorded on the same test template. However, if two or more products of the same material are used, for example type I and type II tape, this testing requirements will be documented on separate test templates.

Temporary Pavement Marking is an Approved Products List (APL) material, thus NDOR Field personnel will authorize the sample record.
