


The Need for Improvement

The purpose of this proposed project is to preserve the transportation asset, improve the reliability of the transportation system, and perpetuate the mobility of the traveling public. The need for this proposed project is based on the current condition of the roadway.

This project would provide much needed improvements to U.S. Highway 281 (US-281) and U.S. Highway 136 (US-136) within the city of Red Cloud in Webster County.

THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDE:

- Reconstructing pavement
- Constructing new sidewalk and curb ramps
- Removing and replacing existing street lighting; reusing ornamental lighting in the downtown when possible
- Constructing storm sewer and utility improvements




These proposed improvements would improve the travel efficiency and safety along these portions of US-281 and US-136.





Project Timeline

NDOT is currently in the Final Design and Public Input phase of this project. Construction could begin as early as spring 2026 and be completed in spring 2027.








Potential Project Impacts

Red Cloud City Park is within the project area; impacts are anticipated due to sidewalk and curb work.

Effects to historic properties are being evaluated and the proposed project is seeking ways to avoid adversely affecting historic properties.

The proposed project would require the acquisition of additional property rights, which could include new rightof-way (ROW), control of access (CA), permanent easements (PE), and/or temporary easements (TE).

If your property is impacted by this project, you will be contacted by a representative once the design footprint has been established.









Truck Detour Routes

A designated detour for US-136 would utilize Nebraska Highway 10 (N-10), Nebraska Highway 4 (N-4), and Nebraska Highway 78 (N-78). A designated detour for US-281 would utilize N-4, N-78/Kansas Highway 128 (K-128) and US Highway 36 (US-36).

PROPOSED US-281 DESIGNATED TRUCK DETOUR ROUTE









Local Detour Routes

A designated detour for US-136 would utilize Elm Street, 3rd Avenue, and Seward Street. A designated detour for southbound US-281 would utilize W 11th Avenue, Seward Street, and 1st Avenue. Northbound US-281 would be maintained, but phased half at a time.








Typical Cross Sections


US-136/W 4th Ave within Main St Historic District



US-281/Webster St within Main St Historic District




US-281/Webster St outside Main St Historic District
