## 2016 NEBRASKA TEEN DRIVER FACTS

Teen drivers ages 19 & younger represent 7.2% of all licensed drivers in Nebraska; includes all Learner's Permits (LPD), School Permits (SCP), and Provisional Operator's Permits (POP).

In 2016, 100% of the 12 teen traffic fatalities (drivers and passengers, ages 13 -19) were NOT wearing seat belts.

## **TEEN DRIVERS (Ages 19 & Younger) WERE INVOLVED IN:**

- 21% of all reported crashes
- 24% of crashes between 9 p.m. and midnight
- 16% of crashes between midnight and 3 a.m.
- 26% of crashes using a **cell phone**
- 35% of "exceeding the speed limit" crashes
- 18% of "failure to yield" crashes
- 26% of all single-vehicle **rollover** crashes
- 21% of crashes due to **"road conditions"** which were wet and/or snowy
- 23% of "speed too fast for conditions" crashes
- 25% of rear-end type collisions
- 11% of **alcohol-involved** crashes
