2019 Nebraska Teen Driver Facts

Teen drivers, ages 19 & younger represent 7.4% of all licensed drivers in Nebraska; includes all Learner's Permits (LPD), School Permits (SCP), and Provisional Operator's

In 2019, 76% of the 21 teen traffic fatalities (drivers and passengers, ages 13 -19) were NOT wearing seat belts.



TEEN DRIVERS (Ages 19 & Younger) WERE INVOLVED IN:

- 13% of all reported crashes
- 23% of crashes between 9 p.m. and midnight
- 13% of crashes between midnight and 3 a.m.
- 31% of crashes using a cell phone
- 21% of "speed related" crashes
- 17% of "failure to yield" crashes
- 22% of all single-vehicle rollover crashes
- 20% of crashes due to "road conditions" (snow, ice, water)
- 23% of rear-end type collisions
- 10% of alcohol-involved crashes
