## **HIGHWAY PROJECT INFORMATION**

NDOT PROJECT:

M1006 Shubert South; C.N. M1006

The Nebraska Department of Transportation (NDOT) is currently soliciting public input on the proposed culvert replacements along Nebraska Highway 67 (N-67) Richardson County.

Identified as *Shubert South*, the proposed project would replace two culverts along N-67. The proposed project would include culvert replacements at approximately mile marker (MM) 4.66, or about 1.37 miles south of the N-67 and Nebraska Highway 62 (N-62) junction, and at approximately MM 3.93, or about 2.10 miles south of the N-67 and N-62 junction. Construction may begin and/or end approximately 500 feet ahead or beyond the project limits to accommodate transitioning pavement.

The purpose of this project is to preserve the N-67 transportation assets, improve the reliability of the transportation system and perpetuate the mobility of the traveling public. The need for this proposed project is based on the current condition of the culverts.

The proposed improvements for the **Shubert South** project would consist of replacing existing culverts, guardrail removal and flattening of the foreslopes. Additional work would include grading.

The proposed project would require the acquisition of additional property rights which could include new right-of-way (ROW), control of access (CA), permanent easements (PE), and/or temporary easements (TE). If your property is impacted by this project, you will be contacted by a representative once the design footprint has been established. Access to adjacent properties would be maintained during construction but may be limited at times due to phasing requirements.

Construction for the proposed project could begin as early as summer 2022 and be complete by winter of 2022.

The majority of this project would be constructed under traffic; however, a detour would be required for N-67 due to the culvert replacements. A designated detour would be provided and would utilize US Highway 73 (US-73), US Highway 75 (US-75), N-62.

The public is being encouraged to make suggestions or express concerns regarding the proposed project. Materials can be provided in alternative languages or formats. Comments will be collected through June 17, 2022. Written comments or requests should be submitted to:
