NOTICE OF HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

# NB US-75 Q St - F St, Omaha

Project NH-75-2(190); C.N. 22867

Identified as **NB US-75 Q St - F St, Omaha**, the proposed project would improve approximately 1.43 miles of northbound U.S. Highway 75 (US-75) in Douglas County.

The proposed work on US-75 would begin south of Q Street, at approximately mile marker (MM) 86.36, and extend north to F Street at approximately MM 87.79. Construction may begin and/or end approximately 500 feet ahead of or beyond the actual project limits to accommodate transitioning the pavement.

Proposed improvements would consist of milling and resurfacing the mainline roadway as well as any adjacent auxiliary lanes to the gore of the on/off ramp.

The purpose of the proposed project is to preserve the transportation asset, improve the reliability of the transportation system and perpetuate the mobility of the traveling public. The need for the proposed project is based on the current condition of the existing roadway.

Additional property rights would not be required. Access to adjacent properties would be maintained during construction but may be limited at times due to phasing requirements.

No wetland and/or other water resource impacts are anticipated due to the urban nature of the project. Highland Park is in the project area; however, no impacts to this property are anticipated.

Construction is tentatively scheduled to begin in spring of 2023, with anticipated completion by winter of 2023.

This project would be constructed primarily under traffic with lane closures controlled by

appropriate traffic control devices and practices. A majority of the project work would occur at night. Temporary overnight ramp closures would be required at the following locations:

- NB Q Street On-Ramp
- NB L Street Off-Ramp
- NB L Street On-Ramp
- NB F Street On-Ramp

Suggested alternate routes would be provided. The NB Q Street On-Ramp and NB L Street Off-Ramp closures would occur simultaneously. Additionally, the NB L Street On-Ramp and NB F Street On-Ramp closures would occur simultaneously. Drivers would need to utilize alternate routes during these short-term closures.

NDOT has worked to develop this project to minimize inconvenience and hardships. We are dedicated to improving Nebraska's highway system and with your help we can achieve this goal.

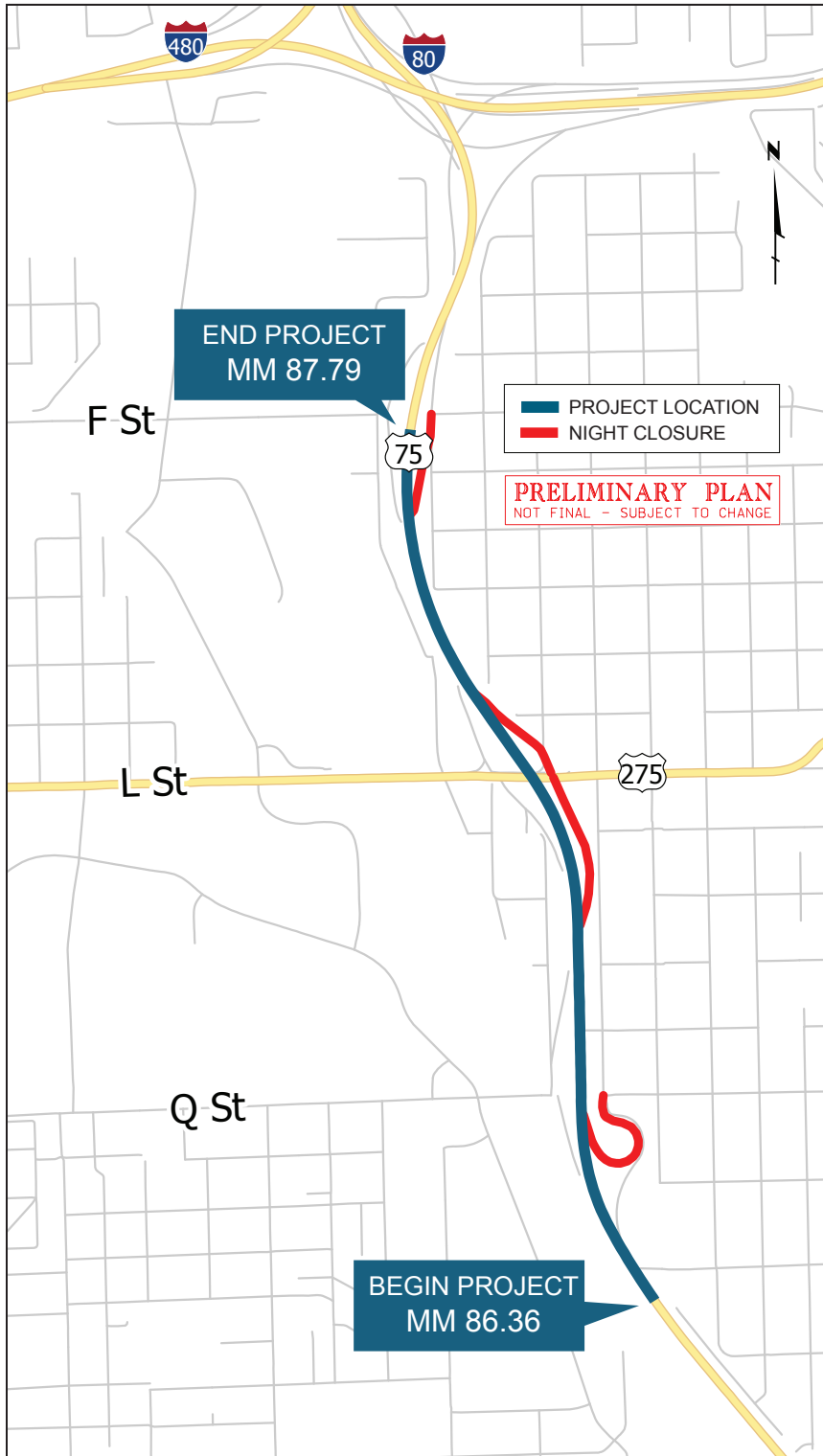
