### Overnight closure of northbound I-180 and southbound I-180 to eastbound I-80 loop

**July 6, 2026 (Lincoln, Neb.)** — Weather permitting, northbound Interstate 180 (I-180), a portion of westbound U.S. Highway 34 (US-34), and the southbound I-180 loop to eastbound Interstate 80 (I-80) will be closing the night of July 13, according to the Nebraska Department of Transportation.

Northbound I-180 will be closed at the Superior Street interchange. Access to eastbound I-80 from the Superior Street interchange will be closed. Northbound I-180 traffic planning to travel eastbound or westbound on I-80 will be detoured to the I-180 and Cornhusker Highway interchange where they will travel westbound on Cornhusker Highway to access I-80 at the I-80 and Cornhusker Highway interchange. Southbound I-180 traffic planning to travel eastbound on I-80 will be detoured onto westbound I-80 to the I-80 and Cornhusker Highway interchange to access eastbound I-80. The closures will begin at 9 p.m. and will reopen the following morning at 6 a.m.

Overhead sign structures near the I-80 and I-180 interchange will be removed to facilitate construction of traffic crossovers and replacement of the I-180 bridges over I-80.
