Scope of Work	Page 1	2. We notice that the scope of work/locations criteria of this bid is similar to Nebraska NEVI R231-24 November 2024. Kindly clarify if RFP# 123703 Z6 is a Round/Phase 2 or reopening of R231-24.	All proposals for R231-24 were rejected following FHWA guidance on suspending State EV Infrastructure Deployment Plans.  With new guidance, NDOT is reissuing the NEVI Formula Program RFP with minor edits to the previous version.
Scope of Work	Page 1	3. Also please let us know if R231-24 is still under review or if it is to be awarded since we had previously submitted sites in 2024.	All proposals for R231-24 were rejected following FHWA guidance on suspending State EV Infrastructure Deployment Plans.
		4. Are there any union labor requirements?	All contractors and subcontractors performing work under this federally funded program must comply with applicable federal labor standards, including:  • Davis-Bacon and Related Acts (40 U.S.C. §§ 3141–3148) – requiring payment of locally prevailing wages and fringe benefits, as determined by the U.S. Department of Labor, for all construction work financed in whole or in part with Federal-aid highway funds.

			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act (40 U.S.C. §§ 3701–3708) – establishing overtime compensation requirements.</li> <li>• Copeland “Anti-Kickback” Act (40 U.S.C. § 3145) – prohibiting improper deductions from employee wages.</li> </ul> <p>NDOT requires all NEVI-funded projects to incorporate these provisions consistent with 23 U.S.C. 113 and FHWA Form 1273, which must be included in all prime contracts and subcontracts. Contractors must ensure full compliance with the above federal labor standards and any applicable Nebraska employment laws.</p>
		5. Is an estimated budget or cost range available?	NDOT does not publish a specific cost range to maintain competitive fairness.
		6. Is there an anticipated start and completion date for when this work should begin and end?	<p>The anticipated timeline for projects funded under NEVI Formula Program funds will align with federal obligation and construction requirements. Projects are expected to begin construction within 12 months of obligation, consistent with 23 CFR 630.106 and 23 CFR 635.122, unless an alternative schedule is approved by FHWA.</p> <p>As part of the proposal and contracting process, selected vendors will be required to provide a specific construction start and completion date for each awarded site. These dates will be reviewed and approved by NDOT to ensure compliance with project scheduling, FHWA oversight, and timely expenditure of federal funds.</p> <p>All project expenditures will occur prior to project closeout and final reimbursement per FHWA requirements.</p>
