Presentation Focus: The panel will be well versed in the organizational structure and technical responses provided in the Statement of Qualification for this RFQ. NDOT asks that you not focus a lot of time presenting on those areas unless there have been changes you want to highlight. Instead, NDOT suggests the interview contains information such as the following:

- Describe your experience with Esri system architecture transitions (from a shared environment to managed). Do you recommend single ArcGIS Enterprise Portal deployment or two separate portals one for Roads and Highways Portal and one Production Portal? What does a successful transition look like to you?
- Recommended strategies to maintain continuity and avoid downtime when migrating from one Enterprise Portal to a new Portal environment?
- What additional HPMS validations processes or tools do you recommend outside of Esri Roads and Highways? What processes would be manual and what can be automated?
- Migrating from a mainframe LRS to Roads and Highways, how do you maintain parallel operations during the transition, and what criteria do you use to define the final cut-over date?
- Describe your experience with FME ETL and automations along with FME ProjectWise integrations?
- Each firm should be prepared to answer a variety of Committee questions at the conclusion of their prepared presentation.
