#### **About Highway Safety Office's Grants**

Project Grants are available to organizations for traffic safety projects and activities. Applications for projects with the potential to impact the priority traffic safety areas are annually reviewed.

Funding assistance through mini-grants is also available to law enforcement for the following items: preliminary breath testing (PBT) units, radar units, in-car video cameras, and selective overtime enforcement. Law enforcement and other eligible non-profit organizations are also provided with funding assistance for car safety seats, traffic safety training/workshops/conferences, and public information and education activities.

#### SAM.gov registration, CAGE Code, and UEI

Federal guidelines require the NDOT-Highway Safety Office (HSO) to ensure that all applicants are not suspended or debarred from receiving federal grants by having an active registration at the System for Award Management (SAM). The Commercial and Government Entity (CAGE) Code, and the Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) are required to register at Sam.gov. Grant Applications without the CAGE Code, and the Unique Entity

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#### Selective Overtime Enforcement Download Application

Effective February 1, 2016, mileage will no longer be an eligible reimbursement expenditure.

Funding assistance for selective overtime enforcement is available to law enforcement agencies in the priority counties. The selective overtime activity may be conducted in one of four emphasis areas: occupant protection, speed, alcohol, or general traffic. Overtime salaries are eligible for reimbursement. All officers working grant funded alcohol selective overtime enforcement must be certified in Standard Field Sobriety Testing (SFST). Course completion certificates will be required with the claim for reimbursement. Applications must be submitted for approval a minimum of 30 days prior to the start of activity.

The mini-grant contractor is responsible for submitting the Mini-Grant Claim for Reimbursement (CR) with a copy of support documentation substantiating expenditures associated with each mini-grant contract issued. The request(s) must be completed and submitted to the NOHS as reimbursement is needed and/or upon completion of the mini-grant contract. CRs are processed upon receipt of the correct documentation.

The Grant Funded Enforcement Activity Summary must be completed and returned with the reimbursement request.

2) incur the expenses (pay the bills); 3) request reimbursement on a Mini-Grant Contract Claim for Reimbursement (CR) located on the NDOT-H5O website at http://doi.nebraska.gov/safety/hso/grants/grant-forms/; and 4) complete the CR and attach the required supporting documentation as prescribed below.

- c) Provide the name, number of hours worked, regular and overtime hourly rates, and SFST certificate (alcohol only) for each officer.



#### KEARNEY POLICE - CRUISE NITE 2023 ACTIVITY

During the 2023 Cruise Nite event, organizers once again saw thousands of participates, attendees, volunteers, and residents come together for a safe and enjoyable weekend. We received excellent cooperation from the community, the businesses and citizens both from Kearney and those that came to Kearney to enjoy the activities.

"The Kearney Police Department, our allied law enforcement agencies, other city departments and community partners deployed resources, extra officers, technology, and effective strategies in preparation for the annual Cruise Nite event. Through cooperation from our community and collaboration with the event organizers this event was once again safe and enjoyable for those in attendance. There were 201 calls for service between 6pm on Friday, July 14th, through 6am on Sunday, July 16th. KPD investigated 11 traffic accidents (2 with injury) and performed 51 traffic stops during this time. These numbers only reflect statistics from the Kearney Police Department. Law enforcement officers from Kearney Police Department, Buffalo County Sheriff's Office, Nebraska State Patrol, and U.N.K. Police all collaboratively worked together for Cruise Nite.
