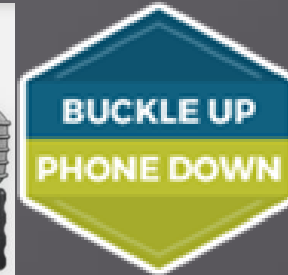

### About Highway Safety Office's Grants

**Project Grants** are available to organizations for traffic safety projects and activities. Applications for projects with the potential to impact the priority traffic safety areas are annually reviewed.

Funding assistance through **mini-grants** is also available to law enforcement for the following items: preliminary breath testing (PBT) units, radar units, in-car video cameras, and selective overtime enforcement. Law enforcement and other eligible non-profit organizations are also provided with funding assistance for car safety seats, traffic safety training/workshops/conferences, and public information and education activities.

### SAM.gov registration, CAGE Code, and UEI

Federal guidelines require the NDOT-Highway Safety Office (HSO) to ensure that all applicants are not suspended or debarred from receiving federal grants by having an active registration at the System for Award Management (SAM). The Commercial and Government Entity (CAGE) Code, and the Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) are required to register at Sam.gov. **Grant Applications without the CAGE Code, and the Unique Entity**

Effective February 1, 2016, mileage will no longer be an eligible reimbursement expenditure.

Funding assistance for selective overtime enforcement is available to law enforcement agencies in the priority counties. The selective overtime activity may be conducted in one of four emphasis areas: occupant protection, speed, alcohol, or general traffic. Overtime salaries are eligible for reimbursement. All officers working grant funded alcohol selective overtime enforcement must be certified in Standard Field Sobriety Testing (SFST). Course completion certificates will be required with the claim for reimbursement. Applications must be submitted for approval a minimum of 30 days prior to the start of activity.

The mini-grant contractor is responsible for submitting the [Mini-Grant Claim for Reimbursement \(CR\)](#) with a copy of support documentation substantiating expenditures associated with each mini-grant contract issued. The request(s) must be completed and submitted to the NOHS as reimbursement is needed and/or upon completion of the mini-grant contract. CRs are processed upon receipt of the correct documentation.

The [Grant Funded Enforcement Activity Summary](#) must be completed and returned with the reimbursement request.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The purpose of this mini-grant contract is to provide funding assistance to law enforcement agencies for selective overtime enforcement in the emphasis area of: (Check One) [Occupant Protection ] [Alcohol ] [Speed ] [Distracted Driving ] [or General Traffic ]. The funding assistance will provide reimbursement for overtime salaries. Regular traffic enforcement activities must remain at the current level and all activities funded by this mini-grant must be above and beyond the current level of enforcement activity.

**1. Baseline Information:**  
During Cruise Nite, Kearney is inundated with accidents, traffic violations, assaults, disturbances, liquor violations and gang activity.

**2. Selective Overtime Enforcement Objective:**  
Decrease the amount of accidents, disturbances, assaults, property damage accidents, liquor law violations, impaired driving and gang activity.

**3. Selective Overtime Enforcement Activity:**  
Saturation patrols in the area of Cruise Nite on Saturday, July 15th through Sunday, July 16th at 0600.

**4. Selective Overtime Enforcement Budget:**  
Twenty-three officers (\$50/hour) for 8 hours of overtime = \$9,200. Six supervisors (\$60/hour) for 8 hours of overtime = \$2880. Total Request = \$12,080

**5. Impact Evaluation:**  
Reduce accidents, disturbances, assaults, property damage incidents, liquor law violations, impaired driving and gang activity.

Within sixty (60) days from the conclusion of the activity the reimbursement request must be submitted. After sixty (60) days, reimbursements may not be honored. This mini-grant contract is financed on a reimbursement basis. The applicant must 1) receive approval of the mini-grant contract from the NDOT-HSO; 2) incur the expenses (pay the bills); 3) request reimbursement on a Mini-Grant Contract Claim for Reimbursement (CR) located on the NDOT-HSO website at <http://dot.nebraska.gov/safety/hso/grants/grant-forms/>; and 4) complete the CR and attach the required supporting documentation as prescribed below.

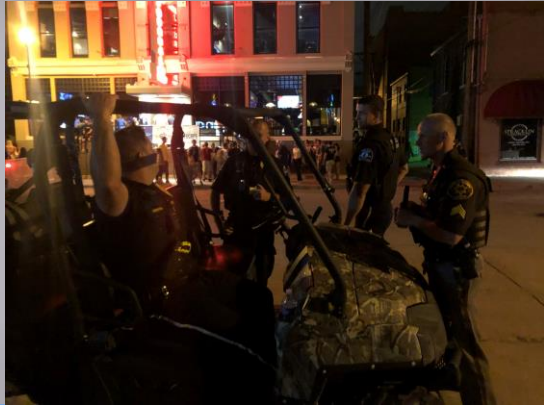

**KEARNEY POLICE - CRUISE NITE 2023 ACTIVITY**

During the 2023 Cruise Nite event, organizers once again saw thousands of participants, attendees, volunteers, and residents come together for a safe and enjoyable weekend. We received excellent cooperation from the community, the businesses and citizens both from Kearney and those that came to Kearney to enjoy the activities.

"The Kearney Police Department, our allied law enforcement agencies, other city departments and community partners deployed resources, extra officers, technology, and effective strategies in preparation for the annual Cruise Nite event. Through cooperation from our community and collaboration with the event organizers this event was once again safe and enjoyable for those in attendance. I appreciate the time, attention, planning, and hard work from our staff and the continued support of all our partners and community." – Chief Bryan Waugh

There were 201 calls for service between 6pm on Friday, July 14<sup>th</sup>, through 6am on Sunday, July 16<sup>th</sup>. KPD investigated 11 traffic accidents (2 with injury) and performed 51 traffic stops during this time. These numbers only reflect statistics from the Kearney Police Department. Law enforcement officers from Kearney Police Department, Buffalo County Sheriff's Office, Nebraska State Patrol, and U.N.K. Police all collaboratively worked together for Cruise Nite.

A summary of the weekend activity related to the event includes:

- Assault (3)
- Disturbances (6)
- Vandalism (3)
- Larceny (6)
