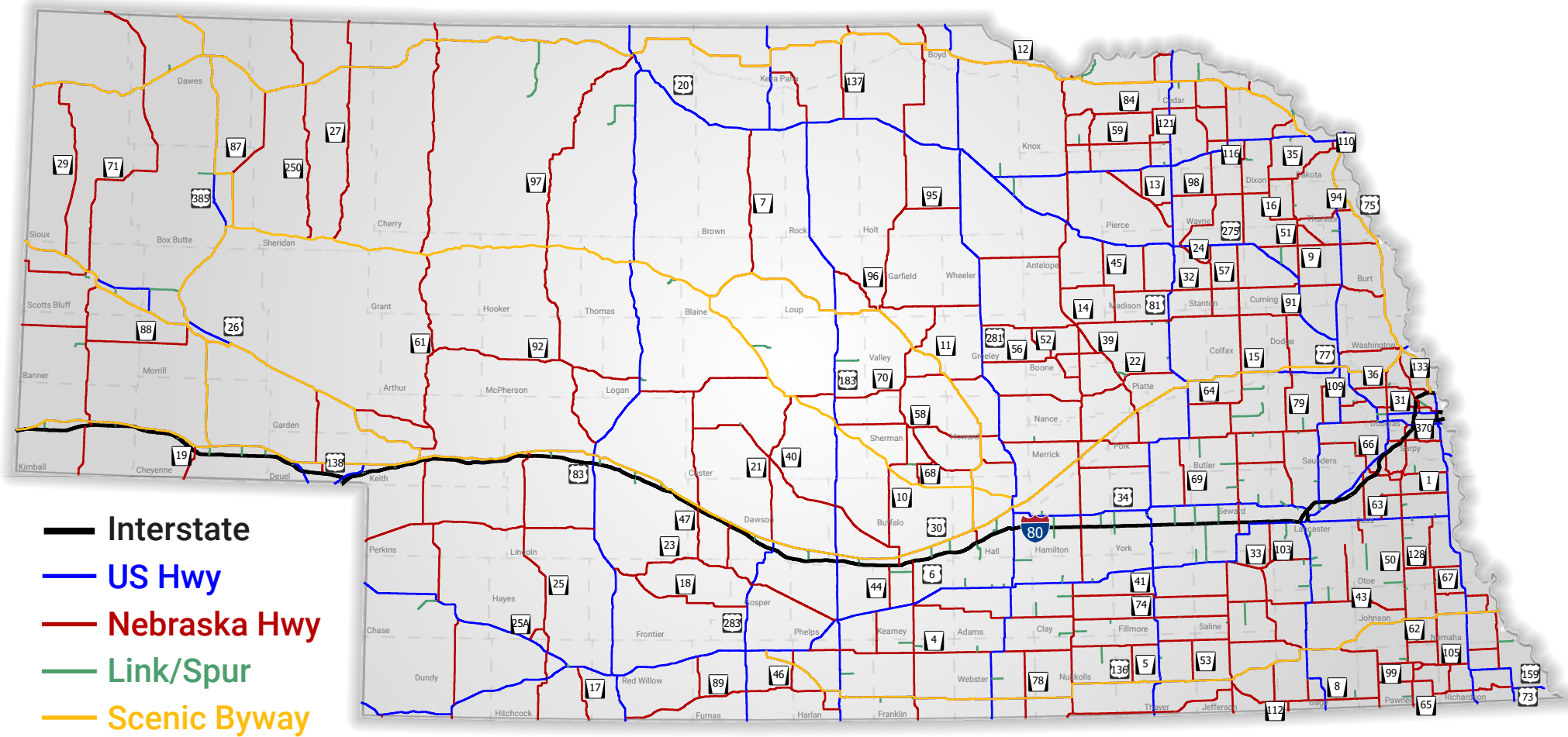


NEBRASKA HIGHWAY SYSTEM



Nebraska State Highway System

The Nebraska State Highway System consists of all the state highways in Nebraska maintained by the Nebraska Department of Transportation. This includes federally designated Interstates and US Highways as well as state highways, links and spurs. The system comprises 9,942 miles (16,000 km) of state highways in all 93 counties.

Department of Transportation

The Nebraska Department of Transportation is responsible for the planning, development, design, construction, maintenance and administration of the state highway system. Preserving the billions of dollars Nebraskans have invested in their state highway system, making the highways safe and efficient, and accomplishing this in a timely and cost-effective manner are the goals of the Department of Transportation.
