Utility Update

- New Specification – Coordination and Communication
 - Ready to be Deployed
 - Selected Projects
 - Plan from Contractor required
 - Tied closely to project schedule



Contract Administration

- **Cost/time Justification for Extra Work**

- NDOT must document justification of accepting the additional cost/time
- Mobilization

- **Trucking** (or anyone, really)

- Payrolls required when there is a subcontract, on federally funded projects
- Must be either a subcontract OR a lease agreement where drivers are carried on the Contractor's payroll

Buy America

- New Transportation Funding Law
 - (5) common construction materials used in public works infrastructure projects, including steel, iron, manufactured products, non-ferrous metals, plastic and polymer-based products (including polyvinylchloride, composite building materials, and polymers used in fiber optic cables), glass (including optic glass), lumber, and drywall are not adequately covered by a domestic content procurement preference, thus limiting the impact of taxpayer purchases to enhance supply chains in the United States
