Presentation Focus: The panel will be well versed in the organizational structure and technical responses provided in the Statement of Qualification for this RFQ. NDOT asks that you not focus a lot of time presenting on those areas unless there have been changes you want to highlight. Instead, NDOT suggests the interview contains information such as the following:

- **Public Involvement/Community Engagement** – Describe the strategies your firm will use to engage stakeholders, and how will you utilize the insight gained to further alternative development.
- **Environmental Evaluation Process** – Describe your approach to evaluating potential environmental risks and identifying circumstances that may trigger elevated environmental reviews, potentially impacting project delivery schedules. Specifically, address how your firm will assess and mitigate risks associated with river and railroad crossings when determining the best project alternatives.
- **Advancing Project from Planning to Construction** – Describe your firm’s experience in transitioning projects from the planning phase to finding potential funding sources for construction and give examples of how you have successfully helped secure construction funds.
- **Cost-Benefit Analysis** – Describe your approach for developing a CBA while determining routes that best meet the transportation challenges in the three project segments. How will schedule/time impacts be incorporated into the analysis.
- Each firm should be prepared to answer a wide variety of Committee questions at the conclusion of their prepared presentation.
