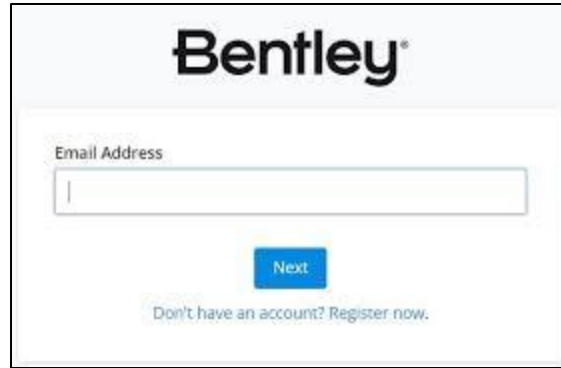

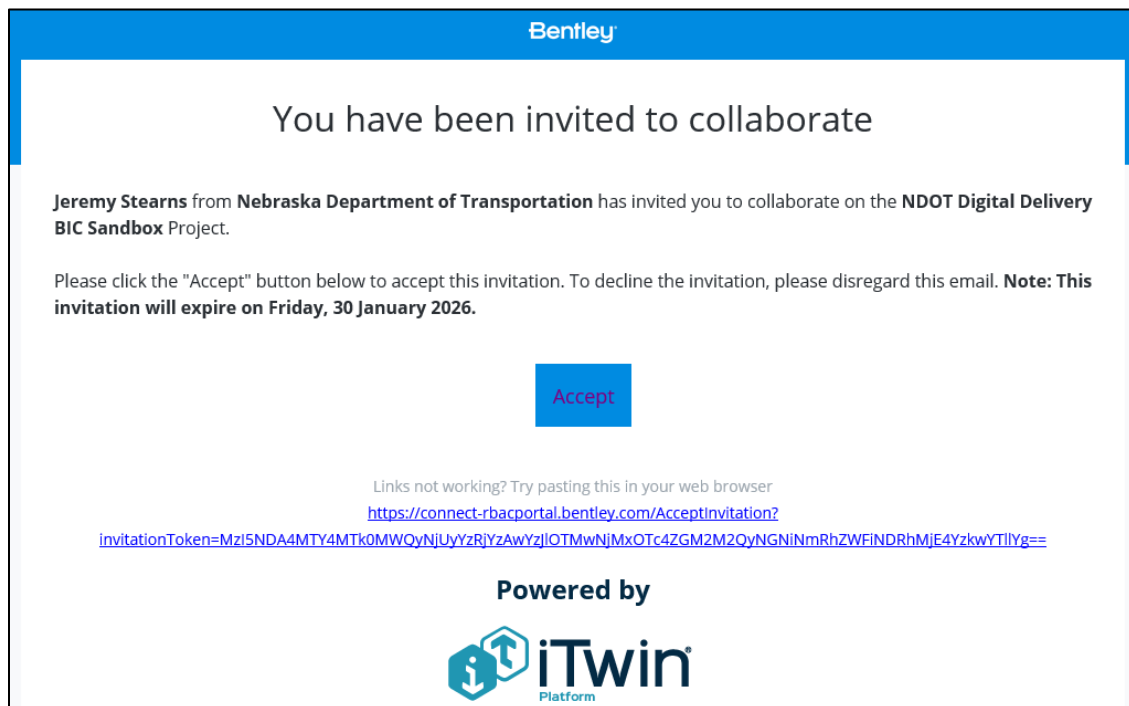

These instructions will guide you through the process of receiving a Bentley Infrastructure Cloud (BIC) Project Invitation from the Nebraska Department of Transportation.

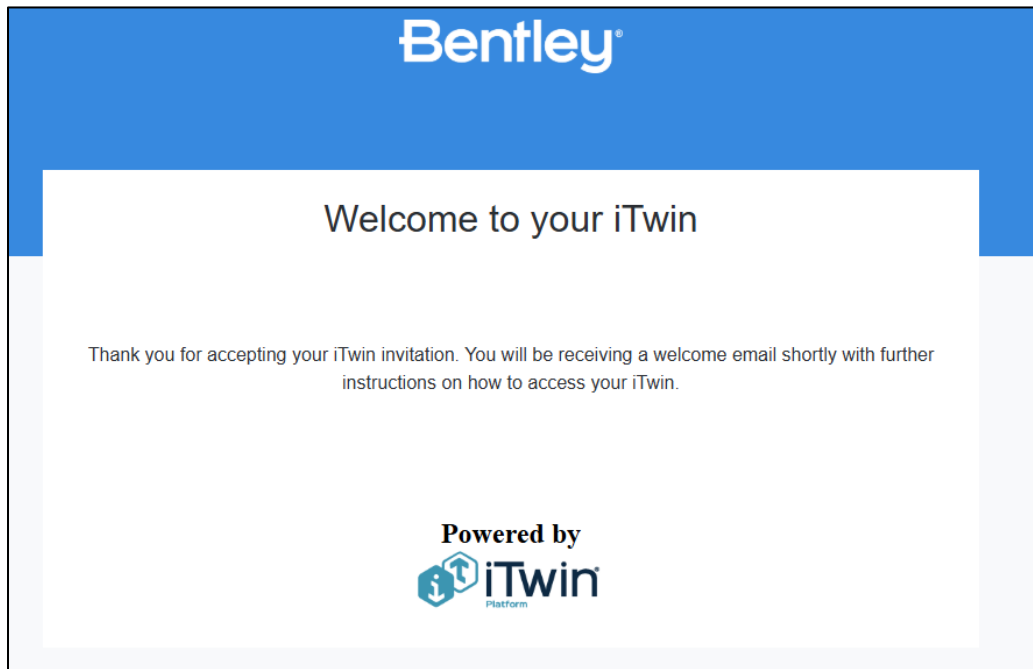
Instructions

1. When you have been invited to Digital Project Delivery (DPD) you will receive an automated email from "noreply@bentley.com".
 - a. Click "Accept".
