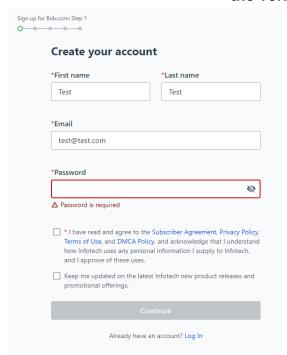

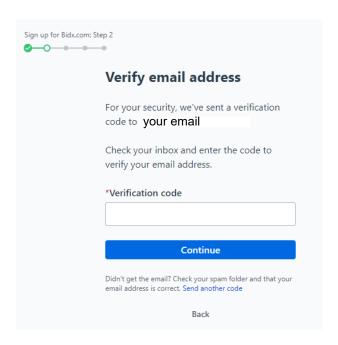
Bidx.com has three account options. The free version is sufficient to see all of the information described in this guide.

- 4. A verification email will be sent to the email you put down. You will need to enter in the verification code to continue.

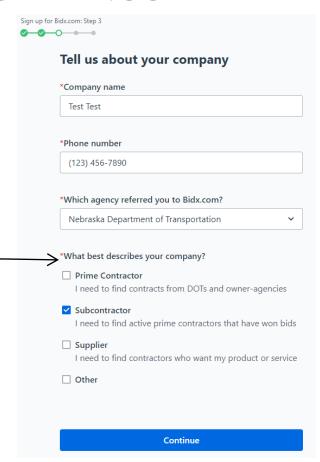






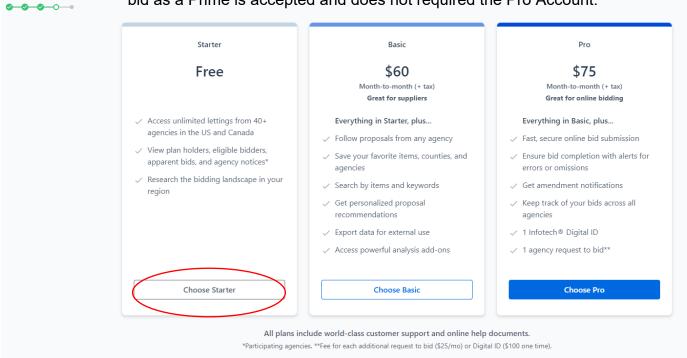
3. Enter Company name, phone number, and select Nebraska Department of Transportation.

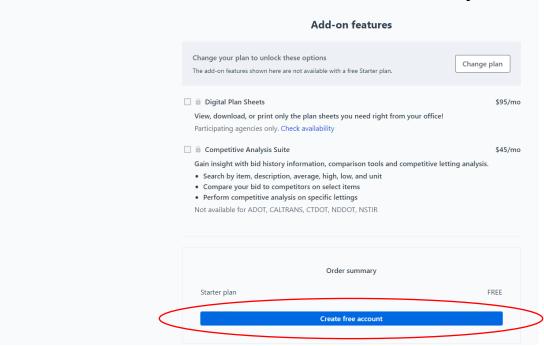


4. Select account type. The free version will give you access to needed documents.

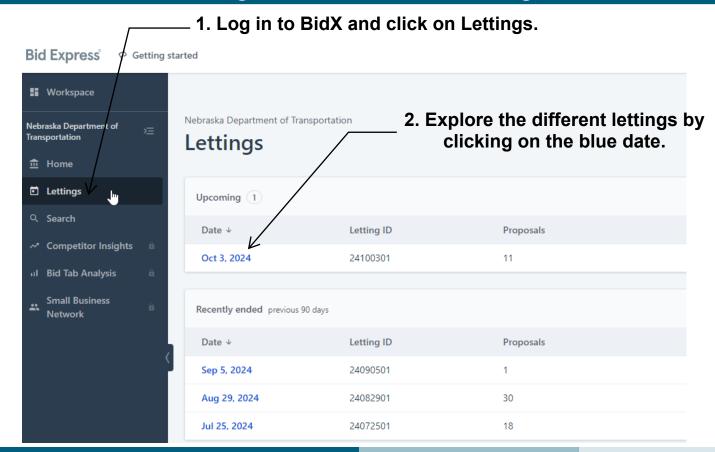
The Pro is needed for Prime Contractors to submit bids electronically. Submitting a paper bid as a Prime is accepted and does not required the Pro Account.



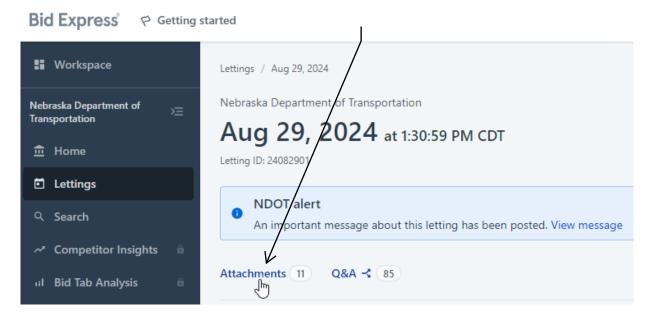
5. You do not need any add-on features to view necessary documents. Click on "Create free account" to be taken to your account.



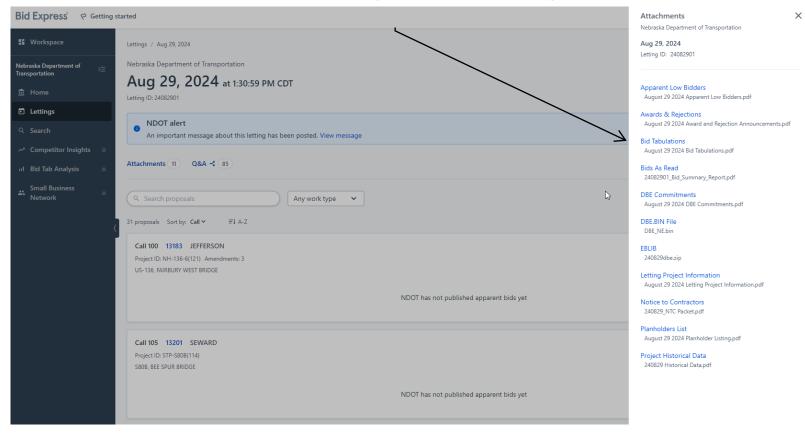
Finding Attachments for the Letting

DOCUMENT BREAKDOWN

Apparent Low Bidders: Typically posted the day after letting. This document reflects ties/limitations and determined apparent low bidders for each project.

Awards & Rejections: Posted once projects are awarded. Lists the projects and status of award/rejection.

Bid Tabulations: Posted as each project is awarded. A breakdown of each line item bid amount from each Contractor's bid per project.

Bids As Read: Posted after the letting is complete. Lists all bidders with their total bid amount. This is what is read during the letting.

DBE Commitments: Lists the projects with a DBE Goal and provides information on the Prime Contractors' DBE Commitments for each project.

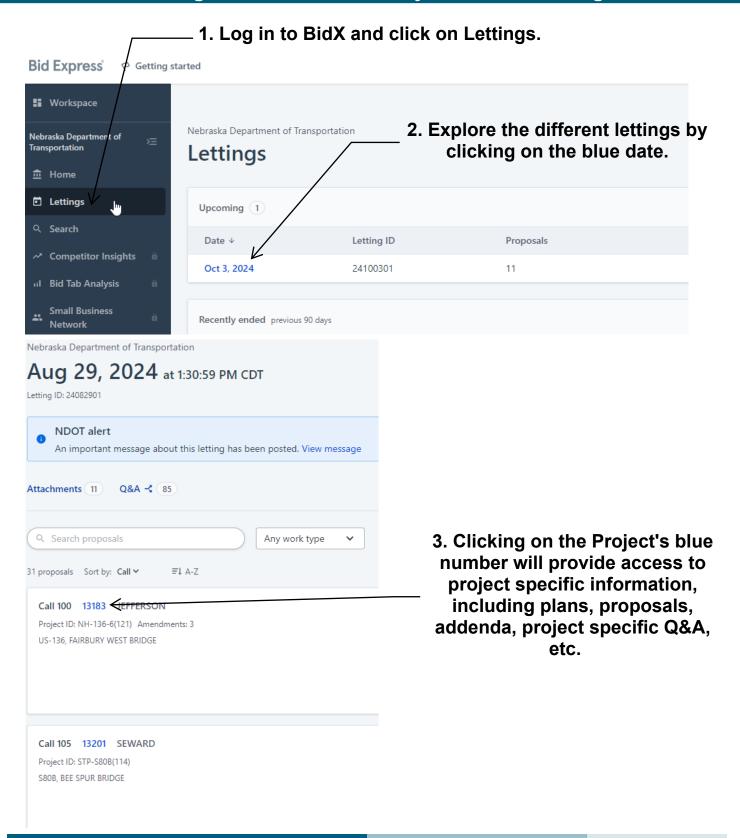

Notice to Contractors: Posted 3 weeks before letting. Provides more information about the projects and indicates which projects have DBE Goals.

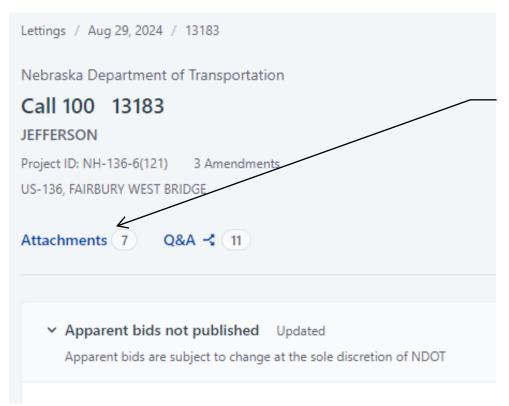
