

S-81-2(1051) York – Columbus; C.N. 42967

The Nebraska Department of Transportation (NDOT) is hosting a public hearing regarding the conceptual design and draft Environmental Assessment for the **York-Columbus** project, which would expand approximately 41 miles of U.S. Highway 81 (US-81) in York, Polk and Butler counties in Nebraska.

This public hearing is being held in compliance with the environmental review process under the National Environmental Policy Act. Attendees will have the opportunity to learn more, ask questions to the project team and provide comments. NDOT will give a formal presentation at 6 p.m., with an open house to follow until 7:30 p.m.



NDOT will make every reasonable accommodation to provide an accessible meeting facility for all persons. Appropriate provisions to provide effective communication, including accommodations for people with hearing challenges, visual impairments or Limited English Proficiency (LEP), will be arranged if NDOT is notified by **Sept. 24, 2024**.
