SAM REGISTRATION

ABOUT: This time of year is when SPAM calls and emails are sent out with offers to renew your SAM registration for a fee. It is **FREE to register or renew at SAM.gov or have us do it for you!** Be wary of the SPAM calls and emails.

ITEM 1: About SAM.

The System for Award Management, or SAM, is a government-wide portal that consolidates the capabilities of multiple systems and information sources used by the Federal government in conducting the acquisition and financial assistance (which includes grants and cooperative agreements) processes.

All entities (people or organizations) wishing to do business with the federal government must register in SAM.

ITEM 2: Why you need SAM.

Airport sponsors in the National Plan of Integrated Airport Systems (NPIAS) must have an active SAM registration to receive federal assistance.

To be considered for federal assistance, the sponsor must submit information establishing financial capability and legal authority to accomplish the project and to operate the airport. The SAM portal collects and stores this data for grant officials' use.

ITEM 3: What you need to do to keep your SAM registration active:

- Registrations must be updated every 12 months to remain active.
- It can take up to 12 business days to get your registration approved. **Plan ahead!**

And remember, Thomas Jacobson is here to help you keep your SAM registration active. You do not need to pay an outside company.
