



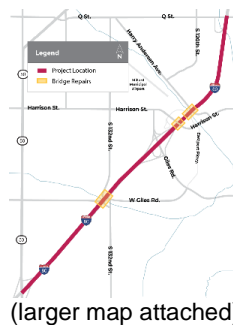

UPDATE: Daytime lane closures to begin tomorrow on the I-80, Q Street to N-50 (144th St) project

April 2, 2025 (Omaha, Neb.) — The Nebraska Department of Transportation (NDOT) announced, weather permitting, daytime lane closures will begin tomorrow, April 3, on Interstate 80 (I-80), Q St to N-50 (144th St) project.

Traffic impacts will include reducing capacity from three lanes to two lanes in both directions of I-80, resulting in significant delays. These lane restrictions will be in place until fall 2025.



The lane restrictions are needed to facilitate construction of an additional lane on westbound I-80 from Q Street to Giles Rd. An additional lane at the N-50 exit, and bridge repairs on the I-80 bridges in both directions over Harry Anderson Ave and Giles Rd will be done as well.

Construction is anticipated to be complete by fall 2025. For more information, please visit ndot.info/22853. The project is the first that came out of the Metro Transportation Improvement Study (MTIS). More information about MTIS is available at ndot.info/mtis.
