Response to Questions – On-call Technical Assistance for Discretionary Grant Applications for Local Public Agencies

June 26, 2024

Statements of Qualifications are due Wednesday, July 3, 2024, 1:00 P.M.

Question: In reviewing the standard work categories, we are certified in all except one (105 Railroad Planning). Is certification in all categories a baseline requirement of the selected consultants, or could a consultant be selected with the understanding that they would not support task orders related to that category?

Answer: Consultant must be certified in all standard work categories. The railroad planning work category is important to confirming or finalizing railroad cost.

Question: Do you anticipate that a consultant who supports an LPA in securing a grant would be impacted in their eligibility to pursue or perform engineering and design work needed for that grant-funded project?

Answer: No

Question: The RFQ indicates that two consultants will be awarded an IDIQ contract. What does NDOT anticipate in terms of the number of active task orders for a given consultant?

Answer: At this point it will be very hard to determine since we are in the beginning stages of standing up the Infrastructure Hub, but it is anticipated a consultant may be given 10-15 task orders under the two-year term.
