QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

NDOT has received comments on the above referenced RFQ, and answers are provided below:

Q1: Page limit for the Statement of Qualifications?

A: No more than twenty-eight (28) pages of material (14 sheets of paper, double sided). This excludes the front and back covers, the two-page cover letter (1 sheet of paper, double sided), table of contents, section dividers, and resumes.

Q2: Will CIP data sheets be made available for any of the projects?

A: All available CIP datasheets have been added to the RFQ documents. Not all anticipated projects have available CIP datasheets.

Q3: Will PCI reports for the three airports be made available?

A: PCI reports have been added to the RFQ documents.

Q4: The RFQ mentions but the projects appear to be related to design and construction, not planning or airport survey. Is inclusion of Airport Planning Services and Airport Survey (FAA-18B Survey) services related to specific projects?

A: Standard work categories for 170-Airport Planning Services and 171-Airport Survey (FAA-18B Survey) are included only as a general capability and no projects have been identified requiring these specific services.
