

Minor Categorical Exclusion for Activities that do not Involve or Lead Directly to Construction

Under the Memorandum of Understanding Between Federal Highway Administration, Nebraska Division and the Nebraska Department of Transportation, State Assumption of Responsibility for Categorical Exclusions, as authorized by 23 USC §326 (herein referred to as the CE MOU and CE Assignment), the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has delegated approval authority of certain Categorical Exclusion (CE) actions to the Nebraska Department of Transportation (NDOT).

NDOT has developed this programmatic Minor Categorical Exclusion (MCE) to document review and approval of certain activities listed under 23 CFR 771.117(c) that, based on past experiences with similar actions, do not involve significant environmental impacts to natural, social and economic resources. NDOT has determined that project-specific NEPA documents and technical resource reviews are not required for actions that comply with the terms and conditions of this MCE. Activities addressed by this MCE, which are not part of a larger undertaking, shall be administered in accordance with the following criteria to satisfy NDOT's CE assignment responsibilities.

Activities classified under 23 CFR 771.117(c)(1) include but are not limited to: planning and technical studies; grants/funding for training and research activities; funding for law enforcement and training (i.e., salaries, equipment purchase, and information materials); funding for the development of Information Technology support materials (i.e., programs, guidelines, software); funding for NDOT and Local Transportation Assistance Program training and equipment; funding for byways information and marketing material; Safe Routes to School education/outreach (non-infrastructure) projects.

Based on the nature of *Activities that do not Involve or Lead Directly to Construction*, NDOT does not anticipate negative impacts to natural, cultural, historic or recreational resources; these activities do not negatively impact air, noise, water quality, hazardous materials, or travel patterns, and do not present any negative cumulative impacts. NDOT has determined that *Activities that do not Involve or Lead Directly to Construction* do not affect listed species, historic properties, wetlands or Waters of the

U.S., nor do they use Section 4(f) properties. NDOT experience has demonstrated that these types of activities do not generate controversy on environmental grounds.

Individual projects actions approved under this MCE shall be reviewed to ensure unusual circumstances as outlined by 23 CFR 771.117(b) do not exist. If an unusual circumstance is identified, a project-specific NEPA document, in compliance with in compliance with NDOT's Environmental Procedure Manual (EPM) and Nebraska Categorical Exclusion (NECE) guidelines shall be developed to approve the action.

This MCE is consistent with the Statewide Long Range Plan, the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), and applicable Metropolitan or Rural Planning Organizations' Transportation Improvement Programs (TIPs) and Long Range Transportation Plans, and is exempt from regional air quality conformity determinations (40 CFR parts 51 and 93).

Use of this MCE is only allowed if all criteria set forth herein are met.
