HIGHWAY PROJECT INFORMATION

NDOT PROJECT:

NH-L28B(106) L-28B Bridges, Omaha; C.N. 22765

The Nebraska Department of Transportation (NDOT) is currently soliciting public input on the proposed improvements to Nebraska Link 28B (L-28B) in Douglas County.

Identified as **L-28B Bridges, Omaha**, the proposed project would involve repairing structures along a section of approximately 0.75 miles of L-28B, just west of the corporate limits of Omaha.

The project would start approximately 0.44 miles east of the junction of L-28B with U.S. Highway 275 (US-275) at mile marker (MM) 0.44, and extend east to MM 1.19, the grade separation of L-28B under 228th Street. Construction may begin and/or end approximately 500 feet ahead of or beyond the actual project limits to accommodate bridge work and updating guardrail.

The purpose of this proposed project is to preserve the L-28B transportation asset, improve the reliability of the transportation system, and perpetuate the mobility of the traveling public. The need for this proposed project is based on the current condition of the roadway and bridges.

The proposed project would include structure numbers:

SL28B 00048 (Westbound Ramp to US-275)

SL28B 00093Rt (L-28B Eastbound Mainline)

SL28B 00093Lt (L-28B Westbound Mainline)

SL28B 00119 (228th Street Bridge over L-28B)

Proposed improvements on this project would include partial depth deck repairs, bridge deck overlay with membrane, expansion joint replacement, and removing and resetting guardrail on all structures.

The proposed project would not require the acquisition of additional property rights. Access to adjacent properties would be maintained during construction but may be limited at times due to phasing requirements. No wetland or other water resource impacts are anticipated.

This project would be constructed under traffic with lane closures controlled by appropriate traffic control devices and practices; however, the proposed project would require temporary closure of the westbound on-ramp for L-28B at 228th Street. A designated detour would be provided and would utilize Skyline Drive. **Traffic on L-28B would not be detoured.**

Construction is tentatively scheduled to begin in summer of 2023 and would be complete by winter of 2023.

The public is encouraged to make suggestions or express concerns regarding this proposed project. Materials can be provided in alternative languages or formats. Comments will be
