2018 NEBRASKA TEEN DRIVER FACTS

Teen drivers, ages 19 & younger represent 7.3% of all licensed drivers in Nebraska; includes all Learner's Permits (LPD), School Permits (SCP), and Provisional Operator's Permits (POP).

In 2018, 53% of the 16 teen traffic fatalities (drivers and passengers, ages 13 -19) were NOT wearing seat belts.

TEEN DRIVERS (Ages 19 & Younger) WERE INVOLVED IN:

- 21% of all reported crashes
- 33% of crashes between 9 p.m. and midnight
- 17% of crashes between midnight and 3 a.m.
- 30% of crashes using a **cell phone**
- 36% of "exceeding the speed limit" crashes
- 17% of "failure to yield" crashes
- 23% of all single-vehicle **rollover** crashes
- of crashes due to **"road conditions"** (i.e.: snow, ice, water and slush)
- 23% of "speed too fast for conditions" crashes
- 24% of rear-end type collisions
- 12% of **alcohol-involved** crashes
